About the Conference

India has emerged as the fastest growing major economy in the world as per the Central Statistics Organisation and International Monetary Fund and it is expected to be one of the top three economic powers of the world over the next 10-15 years, backed by its strong democracy and partnerships. India's GDP is expected to grow 7.3 per cent in 2018-19. This year's budget 2018-19, focuses on uplifting the rural economy and strengthening of the agriculture sector, healthcare for the economically

less privileged, infrastructure creation and improvement in the quality of education of the country. The government is also committed towards doubling the farmers' income by 2022 and creation of livelihood and infrastructure in rural areas.

The Make in India initiative with an aim to boost the manufacturing sector of Indian economy, to increase the purchasing power of an average Indian consumer, which would further boost demand, and hence spur development, in addition to benefiting investors. The Government of India, under the Make in India initiative, is trying to give boost to the contribution made by the manufacturing sector and aims to take it up to 25 per cent of the GDP from the current 17 per cent. Besides, the Government has also come up with Digital India initiative, which focuses on three core components: creation of digital infrastructure, delivering services digitally and to increase the digital literacy.

India is expected to be the third largest consumer economy as its consumption may triple to US\$ 4 trillion by 2025, owing to shift in consumer behaviour and expenditure pattern, according to a Boston Consulting Group (BCG) report; and is estimated to surpass USA to become the second largest economy in terms of purchasing power parity (PPP) by the year 2040. Andhra Pradesh state is also performing well in the different sectors of the economy. Since, it's a new state, after bifurcation, facing a lot of problems persist and to in improving the agricultural, industrial and service sectors and its allied sectors.
